

Happy Valley Enrichment: Food Policy and Hold Harmless Policy

Snack/Food & Allergy/Medical Information Policy:

For afternoon classes, children may bring a snack for themselves only, and no food may be shared. If there are food/medicine allergies or needs, the instructors must be made aware as well as provided with a plan from the parent/guardian on how to manage.

As the legal guardian, YOU must work with the enrichment instructor to be sure your child has access to his/her medications, as his/her medication in the school office may not be available.

Hold Harmless Policy:

Although I understand that Bellingham School District and the Happy Valley PTA will make every reasonable effort to provide a safe environment, I am fully aware of the special dangers and risks inherent in my child's participation in this activity. Further, I accept full responsibility for the behavior of my child during this activity and agree to hold harmless the school, school district, district employees, volunteers, PTA board members, and the Happy Valley PTA for any injury or illness of any nature whatsoever associated with my child's participation in this activity, negligence notwithstanding.

In the event of an injury or illness, I understand that reasonable effort will be made to contact the parent immediately. However, I know that if the injury or illness appears serious and the parent cannot be reached, the adult in charge will secure emergency medical care as needed. Being fully aware of the risks, I hereby give my consent for my child, the above-named student, to participate in the above-mentioned Happy Valley Enrichment class.
